Matters arising. Non that are not currently on the agenda.

1. Grants: The chair informed the meeting that the funding application to sport England via Well Doncaster was not approved.

2. Conisbrough Galas 7th August: Miners Welfare Field 11am. We are using the Gala to relaunch the Friends of the Craggs. Carol gave a demonstration of the activities she has prepared for the young people attending. These activities have been field tested by Penny's grandchildren. We also hope to showcase our partnerships particularly with DMBC and Shed Heads.

3. Totem poles: These have now been purchased and thanks to Tony G. and Leon C., work has started on the art work. It was also agreed that we redesign the Totem pole using stilt so that we can gain six totem poles in total.

4. Glass in the ladies Valley: Local volunteers led by Leon have cleaned up much of the glass in the valley bottom, but more work is required. Currently The Craggs, plus our partners are looking at ways to make the collecting of the glass done more easily.

5. Tree management: DMBC have carried out a scheme of tree and shrub management on the Craggs and the ladies valley, the Friends of the Craggs were involved in consultation with Dave Hooley DMBC at all stages.
